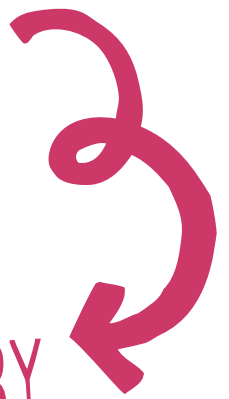




TRANS*? UNDER 25?



KNOW YOUR RIGHTS AT YOUR GP SURGERY

* Trans = someone whose gender is different to the one they were given at birth. Trans is an umbrella term which can include people who identify as transgender, non-binary, no gender, gender-questioning etc

YOU CAN

use whatever name, pronoun, title you want



YOU DON'T

need any documentation to prove it

YOU HAVE

the right to be referred to a gender identity clinic of your choosing by your GP



YOU DON'T

need to go through local mental health services

YOU HAVE

the right to be taken seriously

YOU HAVE

the right to accurate information from your GP

If your GP doesn't know answers to your questions, they should research the NHS guidelines for what to do next
